Monthly Summary

During December 2014, law enforcement in Santa Fe County arrested 68 people for DWI and 4 minors for being under the influence (MUI) or in possession of alcohol (MIP). There were 10 alcohol related crashes and 53 vehicles seized by law enforcement for alcohol related violations.

- The number of DWI arrests increased from 781 in 2013 to 897 in 2014, a 15% increase.
- The number of DWI crashes increased from 106 in 2013 to 140 in 2014 of 2014, a 32% increase.
- As of January 6, 2015 the NM DOT Traffic and Safety Division documented 6 alcohol-involved (AI) crash deaths in Santa Fe County. For the state as a whole, 146 AI crash deaths have been documented. To date, AI crash deaths account for 40% of all motor vehicle crash fatalities in the state and 33% of the motor vehicles crash deaths in Santa Fe County.
