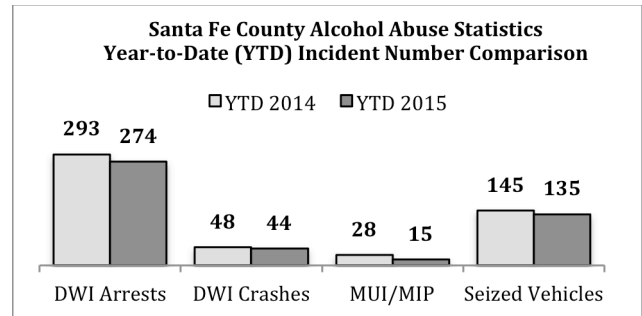
Monthly Summary:

During April 2015, law enforcement in Santa Fe County arrested 61 people for driving while intoxicated and 1 minor for being under the influence (MUI) or in possession of alcohol (MIP). There were 5 alcohol related crashes and 34 vehicles seized by law enforcement for alcohol related violations.

DWI Crashes and Arrests

- The number of **DWI crashes** decreased from 48 in January through April of 2014 to 44 in January through April of 2015, an 8% decrease.
- The number of **DWI arrests** decreased from 293 in January through April of 2014 to 274 in January through April of 2015, a 6% decrease.

Alcohol-Involved (A-I) Motor Vehicle Crash Death

- As of May 4, 2015 there were a total of 82 crash fatalities in New Mexico, 34 (42%) of which occurred due to an alcohol involved crash.
- As of May 4, 2015 there were 3 crash fatalities in Santa Fe County, 1 (33%) of which occurred due to an alcohol involved crash.
