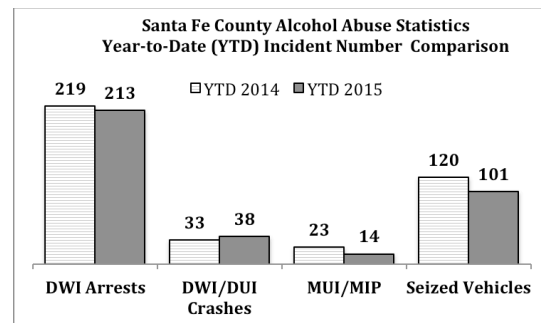
Monthly Summary:

During March 2015, law enforcement in Santa Fe County arrested 83 people for driving while intoxicated and 4 minors for being under the influence (MUI) or in possession of alcohol (MIP). There were 16 alcohol related crashes and 41 vehicles seized by law enforcement for alcohol related violations.

- The number of **DWI crashes** increased from 33 in January through March of 2014 to 38 in January through March of 2015, a 15% increase.
- The number of **DWI arrests** decreased from 219 in January through March of 2014 to 213 in January through March of 2015, a 2% decrease.

Alcohol-Involved (A-I) Motor Vehicle Crash Death

- As of April 6, 2015 there were 22 total A-I crash deaths in New Mexico, one of those alcohol-involved crash deaths occurred in Santa Fe County.
