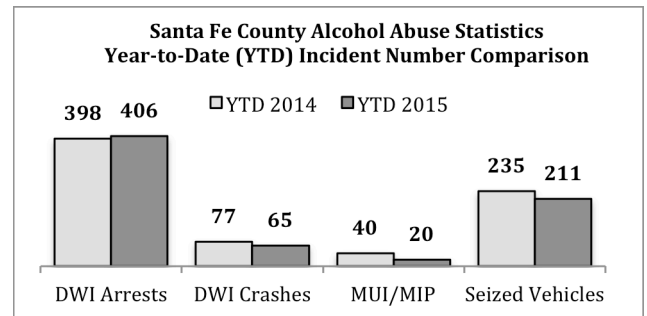
Monthly Summary:

During June 2015, law enforcement in Santa Fe County arrested 59 people for driving while intoxicated and 1 minor for being under the influence (MUI) or in possession of alcohol (MIP). There were 7 alcohol related crashes and 34 vehicles seized by law enforcement for alcohol related violations.

DWI Crashes and Arrests

- The number of **DWI crashes** decreased from 77 in January through June of 2014 to 65 in January through June of 2015, a 2% decrease.
- The number of **DWI arrests** increased from 398 in January through June of 2014 to 406 in January through June of 2015, a 15% decrease.

Alcohol-Involved (A-I) Motor Vehicle Crash Death

- As of July 9, 2015 there were a total of 98 crash fatalities in New Mexico, 54 (42%) of which occurred due to an alcohol involved crash.
- As of July 9, 2015 there were 4 crash fatalities in Santa Fe County, 2 (50%) of which occurred due to an alcohol involved crash.
