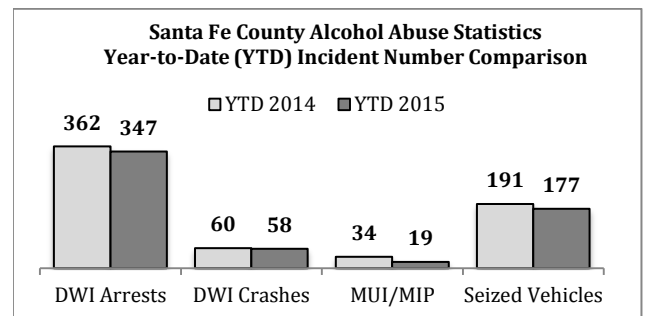
Monthly Summary:

During May 2015, law enforcement in Santa Fe County arrested 73 people for driving while intoxicated and 5 minors for being under the influence (MUI) or in possession of alcohol (MIP). There were 14 alcohol related crashes and 42 vehicles seized by law enforcement for alcohol related violations.

**DWI Crashes and Arrests**

- The number of **DWI crashes** decreased from 58 in January through May of 2014 to 60 in January through May of 2015, a 4% decrease.
- The number of **DWI arrests** decreased from 362 in January through May of 2014 to 347 in January through May of 2015, a 3% decrease.

**Alcohol-Involved (A-I) Motor Vehicle Crash Death**

- As of June 2, 2015 there were a total of 98 crash fatalities in New Mexico, 36 (37%) of which occurred due to an alcohol involved crash.
- As of June 2, 2015 there were 3 crash fatalities in Santa Fe County, 1 (33%) of which occurred due to an alcohol involved crash.
