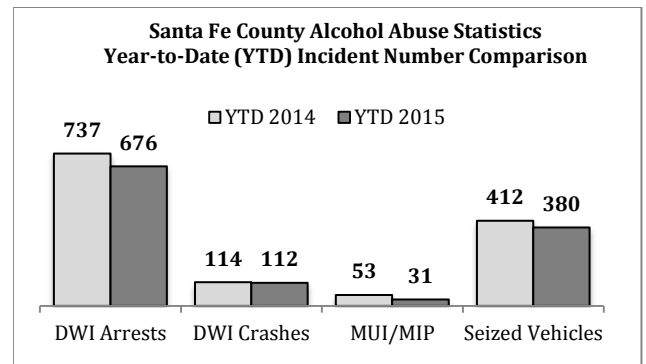
Monthly Summary:

During October of 2015, law enforcement in Santa Fe County arrested 58 people for driving while intoxicated and 4 minors for being under the influence (MUI) or in possession of alcohol (MIP). There were 6 alcohol related crashes and 34 vehicles seized by law enforcement for alcohol related violations.

DWI Crashes and Arrests

- The number of **DWI crashes** decreased from 114 in January through October of 2014 to 112 in January through October of 2015, a 2% decrease.
- The number of **DWI arrests** decreased slightly from 737 in January through October of 2014 to 676 in January through October of 2015, an 8% decrease.

Alcohol-Involved (A-I) Motor Vehicle Crash Death

- As of October 8, 2015 there were a total of 218 crash fatalities in New Mexico, 89 (41%) of which occurred due to an alcohol involved crash.
- As of October 8, 2015 there were 8 crash fatalities in Santa Fe County, 2 (25%) of which occurred due to an alcohol involved crash.
