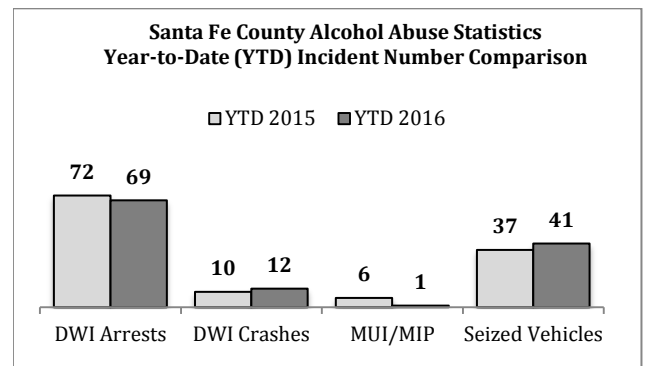
Monthly Summary:

During January of 2016, law enforcement in Santa Fe County arrested 69 people for driving while intoxicated, one of which was a minor between 18 and 20 years of age. There were 12 alcohol related crashes and 41 vehicles seized by law enforcement for alcohol related violations. One minor was cited for being under the influence (MUI) or in possession of alcohol (MIP).

**DWI Crashes and Arrests**

- The number of **DWI crashes** increased from 10 in January 2015 to 12 in January 2016, a 20% increase.
- The number of **DWI arrests** decreased slightly from 72 in January 2015 to 69 in January 2016, a 4% decrease.

**Alcohol-Involved (A-I) Motor Vehicle Crash Death**

- As of February 2, 2016 there were a total of 20 crash fatalities in New Mexico, 5 (25%) of which occurred due to an alcohol involved crash.
- As of February 2, 2016 there were 0 crash fatalities in Santa Fe County.
