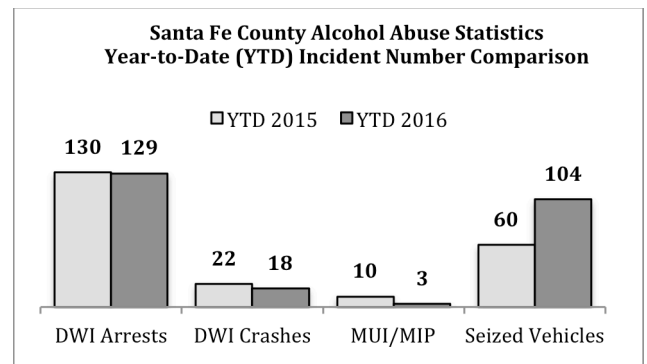
Monthly Summary:

During February of 2016, law enforcement in Santa Fe County arrested 59 people for driving while intoxicated, one of which was a minor between 18 and 20 years of age and one was a juvenile. There were 6 alcohol related crashes and 63 vehicles seized by law enforcement for alcohol related violations. Two minors were cited for being under the influence (MUI) or in possession of alcohol (MIP).

DWI Crashes and Arrests

- The number of **DWI crashes** decreased from 22 in January and February of 2015 to 18 in January and February of 2016, an 18% decrease.
- The number of **DWI arrests** is about the same with 130 DWI arrests in January and February 2015 and 129 DWI arrests in January and February of 2016.

Alcohol-Involved (A-I) Motor Vehicle Crash Death

- As of March 3, 2016 there were a total of 54 crash fatalities in New Mexico, 19 (35%) of which occurred due to an alcohol involved crash.
- As of March 3, 2016 there were 0 crash fatalities in Santa Fe County.
