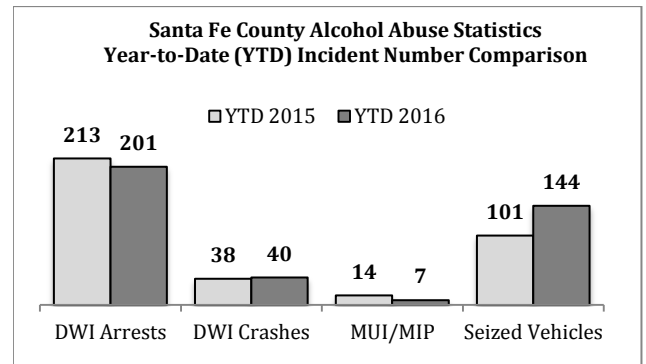
Monthly Summary:

During March of 2016, law enforcement in Santa Fe County arrested 72 people for driving while intoxicated, **one of which was a minor between 18 and 20 years of age and 5 were juveniles.** There were 22 alcohol related crashes and 37 vehicles seized by law enforcement for alcohol related violations. Three minors were cited for being under the influence (MUI) or in possession of alcohol (MIP).

**DWI Crashes and Arrests**

- The number of **DWI crashes** increased from 38 in January through March of 2015 to 40 in January through March of 2016, a 5% increase.
- The number of **DWI arrests** decreased slightly with 213 DWI arrests in January through March of 2015 to 201 DWI arrests in January through March of 2016, a 5% decrease.

**Alcohol-Involved (A-I) Motor Vehicle Crash Death**

- As of April 5, 2016 there were a total of 80 crash fatalities in New Mexico, 26 (33%) of which occurred due to an alcohol involved crash.
- As of April 5, 2016 there were 0 crash fatalities in Santa Fe County.
