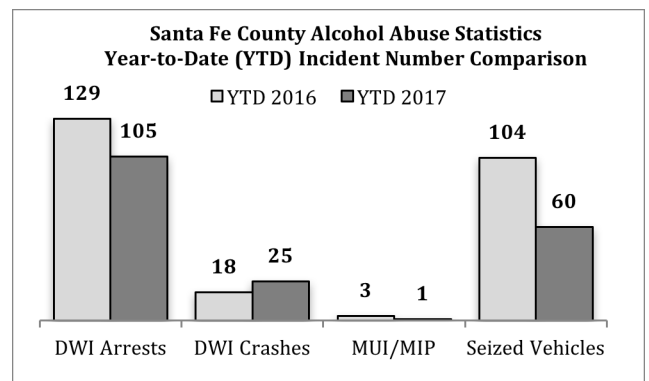
Monthly Summary:

During February of 2017, law enforcement in Santa Fe County arrested 63 people for driving while intoxicated. There were 16 alcohol related crashes and 43 vehicles seized by law enforcement for alcohol related violations. One minor was cited for being under the influence (MUI) of or in possession of alcohol (MIP).

2016 and 2017 Year-to-Date (YTD) Comparison

**DWI Crashes and Arrests**

- The number of **DWI crashes** increased from 18 in January and February 2016 to 25 in January and February 2017, a 40% increase.
- The number of **DWI arrests** decreased from 105 in January and February 2016 to 129 in January and February 2017, a 18% decrease.

**Alcohol-Involved (A-I) Motor Vehicle Crash Death**

- As of March 3, 2017, there were a total of 56 crash fatalities in New Mexico, 15 (28%) of which occurred due to an alcohol involved crash.
- As of March 3, 2017, there were a total of 4 crash fatalities in Santa Fe County, 2 (50%) of which occurred due to an alcohol involved crash.
