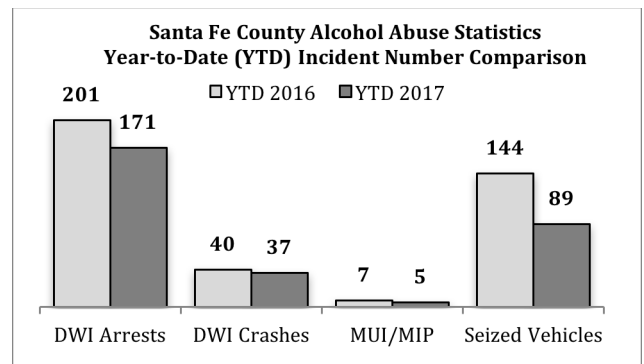
Monthly Summary:

During March of 2017, law enforcement in Santa Fe County arrested 69 people for driving while intoxicated. There were 12 alcohol related crashes and 38 vehicles seized by law enforcement for alcohol related violations. Three minors were cited for being under the influence or in possession of alcohol.

DWI Crashes and Arrests

- The number of **DWI crashes** decreased from 40 in January through March of 2016 to 37 in January through March of 2017, a 7% decrease.
- The number of **DWI arrests** decreased from 201 in January through March of 2016 to 171 in January through March of 2017, a 14% decrease.

Alcohol-Involved (A-I) Motor Vehicle Crash Death

- As of April 4, 2017, there were a total of 81 crash fatalities in New Mexico, 20 (25%) of which occurred due to an alcohol involved crash.
- As of April 4, 2017, there were 4 crash fatalities in Santa Fe County, 2 (50%) of which occurred due to an alcohol involved crash.
